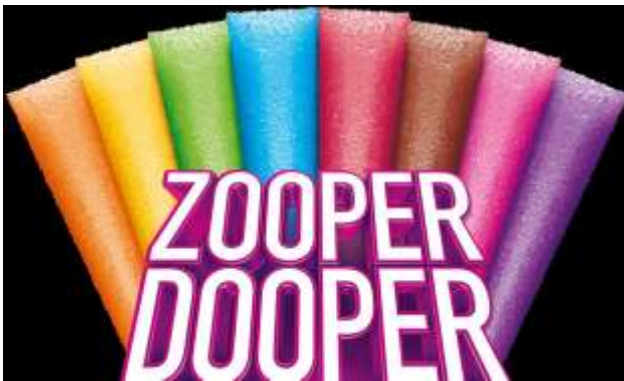
Isis Tigers

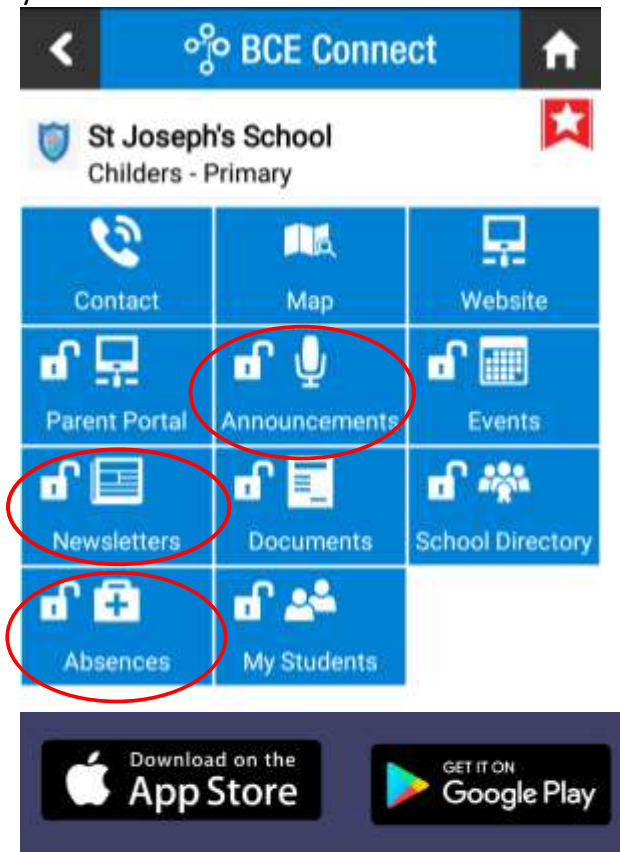

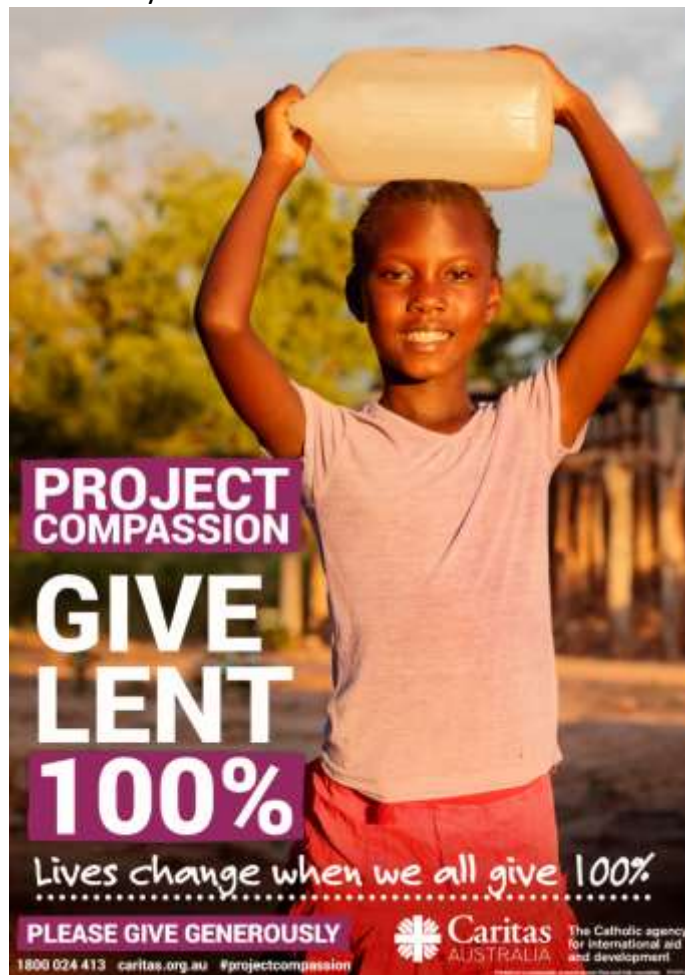
